

EXECUTIVE BOARD OF THE GFD

Article 9 of the GFD Constitution sets out the composition and mandate of the Executive Board as follows:

ARTICLE 9: THE EXECUTIVE BOARD: COMPOSITION, TENURE AND FUNCTIONS

9.1 The Executive Board shall comprise:

- (a) An elected team-ticket comprising the President, Vice President and a Gender Representative each from among distinct member Organisations of Persons With Disabilities (OPWDs) of the GFD;
- (b) Three Experts with required skill sets identified by the Secretariat and approved by the Executive Council; and
- (c) The Executive Director of the GFD as an ex-officio member.

9.2 The Office Bearers shall be:

- a. President;
- b. Vice President;
- c. Gender Representative;
- d. Three Experts; and
- e. Executive Director of the GFD as an Ex-officio member

9.3 (a) The tenure of office of the President shall be four (4) years with no opportunity for renewal.

(b) The tenure of office of the Executive Board shall be four (4) years.

9.4 The Executive Board shall:

- (a) Oversee the implementation of the decisions of the Delegates Assembly.
- (b) Make recommendations to the Organizations of Persons with Disabilities, the Secretariat and the Delegates Assembly.
- (c) Discuss and approve plans and budgets of the Secretariat.
- (d) In consultation with the National Executive Council approve policies and provide strategic direction to the Secretariat.
- (e) Be responsible for the true accounts of all monies received or expended and of all assets and liabilities of the GFD.
- (f) Reserve the right to appoint committees to deal with specific issues.
- (g) The Board shall submit the accounts of the outgoing fiscal year to the auditors not later than three months after the close of the year.
- (h) The Board shall submit to the Annual Delegates Assembly of the GFD the final account as at the close of the previous year.
- (i) Perform such other duties as are specified in the Constitution.
